_____ **Health** – This is a one semester required high school course. The student will receive ½ elective credit toward graduation for this one semester class

_____ **Communication Applications** - This is a one semester required high school speech course. The student will receive ½ required credit toward graduation for this one semester class.

_____ **Art**- Students will learn to use a variety of mediums to produce art projects. The course will also include art history and the fundamentals of design. One semester

_____ **Music**- instrumental – guitar and keyboards

_____ **Drama**- Students will learn theatre history and performance skills. One semester.

_____ **Challenge Math 2**- Problem solving, calculator skills, number sense. This is for students who have previously competed. Instructor approval is needed.

_____ **Journalism** – produce the school yearbook and other publications

_____ **Science and Engineering** - One semester

_____ **Challenge Science** – Students interested in science competitions may sign up for this course second semester. Instructor approval is needed.
